Scholarship Opportunity**

The Eastern Ridge Home Builders Association is proud to partner with the David G. Cook Shooting for Scholarships Fund in offering this scholarship opportunity for the 2026-2027 academic year.

The David G. Cook Shooting for Scholarships Fund was founded by David and Kathy Cook to promote the building industry in which they were successfully involved for 50 years. In 2017, David, who was a longtime member, past president, and honorary lifetime member of the Eastern Ridge Home Builders Association, was diagnosed with terminal brain cancer. Dave had been a past Chair and active participant of the Home Builders Clay Shoot, and in honor of his involvement in the Association and his love for the Outdoors, the Association decided to re-designate the Association Clay Shoot as the “David G. Cook Shooting for Scholarships” Clay Shoot. Funds raised for the Scholarship fund are awarded as Scholarships in fields relating to education in the Building Trades Industry.

David G. Cook Shooting for Scholarships (4 - \$1,000 Scholarships) are available to building and trades students. The scholarships will be available to students participating in educational fields relative to residential construction: Construction Management, Architecture, Building Trades, Engineering (with an emphasis on construction trades), Interior Design, or other related fields of study relative to residential construction.

The eligibility requirements are as follows:

1 - \$1000 Scholarship will be awarded to graduating high school students that are entering a college for a field of study relative to the building and trades industry who is the **son/daughter** of a current Eastern Ridge Home Builders Association member business or the child of an employee of a member business.

1 - \$1000 Scholarship will be awarded to graduating high school students that are entering a college for a field of study relative to the building and trades industry who is graduating from High School in Fond du Lac, Dodge, or Green Lake Counties.

2 - \$1000 Scholarships for students who have already completed one year of secondary education in a field of study relative to the building and trades industry as indicated above. The student must have graduated from a high school in Fond du Lac, Dodge, or Green Lake Counties.

Please note that each scholarship may be earned a maximum of twice per student. To apply, please complete the scholarship application and questions online through the Fond du Lac Area Foundation www.fdlareafoundation.com. Additionally, you will need to include a copy of your most recent transcripts and a letter of recommendation. Please note that these applications do NOT require official transcripts.

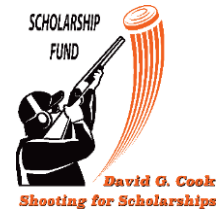
